

Emergency Response Plan

Dear Parents:

Fillmore Christian Academy has an emergency response plan. In case of an emergency, our immediate response is to protect our students and staff.

The students and staff have been taught procedures to follow in the event of an emergency (fire, earthquake, flood, etc.). Periodically drills are held to practice these procedures. Each classroom has emergency supplies.

In the event of an emergency localized at our school/church site, we would move to a safe location on the property or a safe distance away, such as the high school lawn.

In response to an extraordinary emergency situation associated with natural disasters, technological incidents, or national security emergencies, Fillmore Christian Academy will become part of the Fillmore Unified School District plan. Under this plan we will be notified of the emergency and will proceed with our school emergency plan. Depending on the emergency we may be moving our students and staff to San Cayetano School (by walking) for safety.

In either event, students will be safe at school, whether it be on our school property or San Cayetano School. Parents should attend to their own immediate safety needs before attempting to pick up their child.

Please do not call the school to inquire about your child, this will tie up emergency phone lines. You may tune your radio to the City of Fillmore Emergency Station at 1620 AM, KVTA 1520 AM, or KHAY 100.7 FM for emergency information.

The person picking up your child must be someone listed on your school emergency form. Picture I.D. may be required.
